OSHA Course	Description	Contact Hours
Blood-Borne Pathogens	The following course will introduce the student to the federal standards and required knowledge to ensure safety is maintained and protection is taken to avoid risk of exposure to blood-borne pathogens that present to the healthcare worker.	1.0
Electrical Hazards	The following course will provide awareness to electrical hazards and instruct the student on how to recognize them, eliminate or prevent them, and enforce the vital importance of safety.	1.0
Hazardous Materials Awareness	The following course will work to ensure that the student has a thorough understanding at the awareness level surrounding hazardous materials and what actions can be taken if they are encountered. It will also review available resources to aid in identifying the possible released material.	1.0
HIPAA	The following course is aimed to satisfy the training requirements under HIPAA and provide an emphasis on HIPAA privacy, purpose, and means for patient security.	0.5
Introduction to OSHA	The following course will provide an introduction to the student's rights and responsibilities as an employee under the Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) Act.	0.5
Lifting and Moving	The following course will provide an overview of proper lifting and moving techniques for body safety of both the lifter/mover and any person/object being lifted/moved.	0.5
Lock Out/Tag Out	The following course will introduce the student to the federal standards and required knowledge to ensure safety is maintained should an unexpected event occur and energy control measures are warranted.	1.0
Slips, Trips, and Fall Prevention in the Workplace	The following course will provide the student the didactic knowledge and information on safety surrounding fall protection systems and how to use them properly, the maintenance and upkeep of those systems and the OSHA standards	1.0
